

MISSOURI COURSE ACCESS & VIRTUAL SCHOOL PROGRAM (MOCAP)

In accordance with SB 603, the Laquey R-V School District will provide access to virtual (online) coursework for students. Students and families that are interested in virtual course work should complete a Virtual Schooling Intent Form and contact the student's school administrator about the Missouri Course Access Program (MOCAP). Local board policy (6190).

MOCAP offers virtual online courses for students statewide. Students can take an entire course from any internet-connected computer, available 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

MOCAP's mission is to offer Missouri students equal access to a variety of high-quality courses and interactive online learning that is neither time nor place dependent.

The Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) and the State Board of Education oversee administration and quality assurance activities such as related content and delivery of courses.

Missouri certified teachers facilitate MOCAP courses. MOCAP provides Missouri students with equal access to a wide range of coursework, anywhere, at any time. For more information visit the MOCAP website <https://mocap.mo.gov/>.
